BASIC PRINCIPLES OF EVALUATION

- Collect sufficient information to make an accurate assessment.
- Steer clear of generalizations.
- Understand your own biases.
- Document objectively what you observe, not what you think or feel.
- Timely feedback and evaluation are critical constructive feedback should not be a surprise.
- Be direct in your feedback and evaluation. Ambiguity in this time is destructive.
- Genuine, authentic evaluation fosters growth and development.
