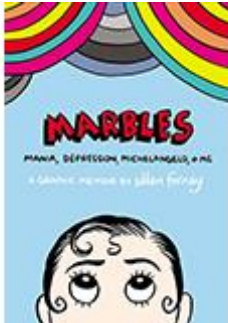


MEET HILAIRE
