A. [Physical Therapy]

Training Requirements: Doctoral Degree
Usual Practice Settings: Private Practice, schools, hospitals, home care, nursing homes, professional athletics
Scope of Practice includes: Practice without a MD prescription
Unusual Practice Setting: Consulting, Film Studios

B. [Occupational Therapy]

Training Requirements: Master's or Entry Level Doctorate
Usual Practice Settings: Private Practice, schools, hospitals, home care, nursing homes, psychiatric facilities
Scope of Practice includes: Driving Assessments
Unusual Practice Setting: Fortune 500 corporations (ergonomics)

C. [Pharmacist]

Training Requirements: Doctoral Degree
Usual Practice settings: Hospitals (inpatient and outpatient care), Community Settings, Clinics
Scope of Practice includes: Health and medication education, treatment consultation, prescribe under protocol, administer medications, provide immunizations
Unusual Practice setting: NASA

D. [Health Administration]

Training Requirements: Bachelor's or Master's degree
Usual Practice Settings: Hospital, Insurance Company, Consulting Firm, Professional Society
Scope of Practice includes: Strategic planning, organizational effectiveness
Unusual Practice Setting: Public Health Department

E. [Physician Assistant]

Training Requirements: Certificate with Bachelor's or Master's degree, Certification exam
Usual Practice Settings: Outpatient primary care, specialty care, and hospital with physician practice plan
Scope of Practice includes: Prescribing medications, performing procedures, mental health and surgery
Unusual Practice Setting: Bush Alaska and Outback Australia

F. [Nurse Practitioner]

Training Requirements: Master's degree or Doctoral degree, Certification exam
Usual Practice Settings: Outpatient clinic/office
Scope of Practice includes: Performs minimally invasive procedures, prescribes medications, and provides comprehensive mental health care
Unusual Practice Setting: Day Care Center (or Phlebotomy lab)

G. [Dentist]

Training Requirements: Doctoral degree
Usual Practice Settings: Outpatient clinic/office
Scope of Practice includes: Performing minimally invasive procedures, prescribes medications, provides oral care
Unusual Practice Setting: Acute care hospital

H. [Public Health Dentist]

Training Requirements: Doctoral degree, plus residency in Public Health, optional: MS/MPH
Usual Practice Settings: Community Health Center, Academic Medical Center
Scope of Practice includes: Performing minimally invasive procedures, prescribes medications, provides oral care
Unusual Practice Setting: K-12 Schools

I. [Chaplain]

Training requirements: Bachelor's or Master's degree
Usual practice settings: Hospital, CCAC
Scope of practice includes: Spiritual care
Unusual practice setting: Policy planner

J. [Physician]

Training requirements: Doctorate, residency training
Usual practice settings: Hospital, clinic
Scope of practice includes: prescribing medication, performing procedures, mental health, preventive care, chronic disease management, acute illness management, acute injury management
Unusual practice setting: Prisons
