ONE-MINUTE LEARNER HUDDLE

The One- Minute Learner “Huddle”

Why huddle? Get to know your preceptor, establish rapport, discuss goals & expectations, & plan for working together.

Reflect on your learning goals, preview schedule & chart.

“Can we touch base to plan for this clinical session?”

1. GOALS: Be specific and reflect on your training; discuss learning goals with your preceptor.

“Are there specific patients or skills I should focus on?”

“I need to work on my patient education skills.”

2. GETTING GOING: Establish when, how, and who you should see in clinic.

“Which patients should I see?”

“Should I room them myself?”

3. HOW MUCH and HOW LONG:

“How much of the visit should I do on my own?”

“How long should I spend with the patient?”

4. PRESENTING: Where and how?

“Where should I present?”

“What format should I use?”

5. CHARTING: When and how?

“What format should I use for notes?”

“When should I write them?”

6. QUESTIONS:

ASK: *“When is a good time to ask questions that come up?”*
